- **Risk Mitigation:** Waiting for an upgrade without securing the currently offered seat may be risky. Opportunities for up gradation decrease over time, and failing to secure the initial admission could result in no college admission at all if the desired upgrade doesn't materialize.
- **Secure Current Admission First:** Candidates are recommended to provisionally accept their present offer by completing the admission process, including paying the required seat booking and residual admission fees, to confirm their seat.
- **Participate in MOP-UP Rounds Strategically:** After securing their spot, candidates can participate in subsequent selection lists or MOP-UP rounds for potential upgrades.
- **Careful Preference Selection:** To prevent being automatically moved to a less-preferred college, candidates must be very careful when giving preferences in MOP-UP round registration. Only list colleges where you are genuinely willing to study. If selected for a new college, the admission in the previous college will be automatically cancelled.
- **Confirmed Back-up:** If a candidate is not selected for an upgrade, their admission in the previously secured college remains confirmed, providing security.
- **Advisory Nature:** This information is a recommendation to help candidates make informed decisions and manage risks, not a mandatory rule.
- **Refund Policy:** For cancellation of admission, all fees are refundable according to the specific refund policy upon submission of a claim. Candidates should refer to the official information from the relevant authority or institution for details on the specific fee refund procedure.
