1st MOP-UP ROUND

The **MOP-UP Registration Process** for admission to the **5 Year B.A. LL.B. Course – 2026** is an important step in ensuring that candidates are considered strictly according to their **merit and preferences**. Giving priority to merit is an essential component of a transparent admission process and is consistent with the principles of natural justice.

A candidate whose name appears in the merit list may participate in the MOP-UP Round by registering through the **University Admission Portal** using his/her **USER ID and PASSWORD**.

Participation in the MOP-UP Round and submission of preference(s) for college(s)/institute(s) shall be entirely at the **discretion of the candidate**.

Important Points to be Remembered

1. Any candidate whose name appears in the merit list **may or may not participate** in the 1st MOP-UP Round. However, a candidate who wishes to be considered for the **next Selection List must register** for the MOP-UP Round. **Only candidates registered in the 1st MOP-UP Round shall be considered for the 2nd Selection List.** A candidate who does not register shall not be considered in the 2nd Selection List. He/she may participate in next MOP-UP Round.
2. An already-admitted candidate who **does not wish to change his/her existing college/institute need not participate** in the MOP-UP Round.
3. A candidate who has already been **selected but has not completed admission** may also participate in the MOP-UP Round. However, he/she **cannot give preference to the college(s)/institute(s) in which he/she has already been selected.**
4. All candidates participating in the MOP-UP Round must exercise their preferences carefully and thoughtfully. If a candidate is selected for any college/institute according to the preferences submitted by him/her, he/she must complete the admission process in the allotted college/institute. If the candidate fails to take admission in the allotted college/institute, he/she will be debarred from participating in the next Round of MOP-UP registration.
A candidate who completes admission in the allotted college/institute may participate in the next MOP-UP Round for further upgradation. Candidates who are not selected in a particular MOP-UP Round may also participate in the next MOP-UP Round by submitting fresh preferences.
Therefore, candidates are advised **not to include any college/institute in their preference list where they are not willing to take admission if allotted.**
5. A candidate who has already been **admitted to any college/institute** may also participate in the MOP-UP Round if he/she wishes to change the college/institute. Such a candidate must exercise his/her preferences **very carefully.**
If the candidate is selected for another college/institute on the basis of the preferences submitted by him/her, his/her admission in the existing college/institute shall be **automatically cancelled**, and the resulting vacant seat shall thereafter be offered to the next eligible candidate in the waiting list, as per the applicable admission rules.

The candidate **must complete the admission process in the newly allotted college/institute**. After completing such admission, he/she may also participate in the **next round of MOP-UP registration for further upgradation**, subject to the applicable rules.

If the candidate **fails to complete admission in the newly allotted college/institute**, he/she shall be **debarred from participating in the next round of MOP-UP registration**.

Therefore, candidates are advised **not to include any college/institute in their preference list where they are not genuinely interested in taking admission**, as allotment against a submitted preference may result in cancellation of their existing admission.

6. If an already-admitted candidate participates in the MOP-UP Round but is **not selected for any of his/her submitted preferences** in the 2nd Selection List, his/her admission in the existing college/institute shall **remain unchanged**.
7. A candidate who, after the 2nd Selection List, has **neither paid the Seat Booking Fee nor the Residual Admission Fee** within the prescribed period shall not be entitled to claim the previously allotted seat after the MOP-UP Round. Similarly, a candidate who has **paid only the Seat Booking Fee but has not paid the Residual Admission Fee** within the prescribed period shall also not be entitled to claim the previously allotted seat after the MOP-UP Round.
8. If a candidate is selected for another college/institute through the MOP-UP Round, he/she shall be required to pay the **Seat Booking Fee and Residual Admission Fee** applicable to the newly allotted college/institute. However, a candidate who has already paid the Seat Booking Fee shall **not be required to pay the Seat Booking Fee again**, subject to adjustment/transfer as per the applicable admission procedure.
9. Candidates selected through the **2nd Selection List** must complete all admission formalities **immediately after selection**, including uploading of the required documents and payment of the applicable **Seat Booking Fee and Residual Admission Fee** within the prescribed period.
10. Candidates are advised to exercise their **college/institute preferences carefully** before submitting their MOP-UP Round registration. The preferences submitted by the candidate shall be considered for subsequent selection **as per merit and the applicable admission rules**.
