Guidelines for Physical Counseling for Next Selection Lists

1. Only candidates who are **called for counseling as per the notification** will be allowed to participate.
 - Candidates should be **physically present** at the counseling venue.
2. Counseling will be conducted **strictly on the basis of merit**, following the selection rules notified on the admission portal, **subject to the availability of vacant seats**.
3. Candidates who are **already admitted** to the LL.M. course in any college, as well as candidates **not admitted anywhere**, may appear for the counseling.
4. If an **already admitted candidate** is selected for admission in another college during physical counseling, **his/her existing seat will automatically become vacant**.
 - The vacated seat will be offered to another eligible candidate from the waiting merit list as per choice and merit.
 - **Under no circumstances** will the candidate be allowed to reclaim the earlier seat in any college/institute.
5. If a candidate is selected for admission in any college through physical counseling **and does not take admission**, his/her **candidature will be treated as cancelled**, and he/she **will not be allowed to participate in any further counseling**.
 - To avoid this, candidates **should not opt for colleges** in physical counseling where they do not wish to take admission.
6. Counseling will continue **until the vacant seats are filled** and/or **eligible candidates are available**.
7. After completion of counseling, the **list of selected candidates** will be published on the **admission portal/website**.
8. Selected candidates must **strictly follow all instructions** mentioned under **“Instructions to the Candidates in Selection Lists.”**
9. If any candidate cancels his/her admission in a college/institute, he/she may submit a **claim for refund of admission fees**.
 - Refund, if applicable, will be processed **as per the prevailing refund policy**.
