

Instructions to the candidates for Entrance Test in

M.Phil. Clinical Psychology 2025-26

All candidates appearing for the Entrance Test are hereby instructed to carefully read and strictly comply with the following guidelines:

1. **One (01) self-attested recent colour photograph must be pasted on the space provided on the Hall Ticket.**
2. No candidate shall be permitted to enter the Test Centre without the Hall Ticket.
3. **Mobile phones, cap/hat, electronic gadgets, smart watches, calculators, stationery items, papers, any such items will NOT BE ALLOWED inside the Test Hall.**
4. The candidate must produce the Hall Ticket for verification at the time of the examination along with any one original valid Photo Identity Proof (Aadhaar Card / PAN Card / Voter ID / Passport / Driving License).
5. The name on the Photo Identity Proof must exactly match the name printed on the Hall Ticket. The Photo Identity Proof must be in good condition and clearly legible. Candidates failing to produce the original valid Photo Identity Proof shall not be permitted to appear in the examination.
6. The Hall Ticket has been issued on the basis of information furnished by the candidate in the application form and is subject to verification at any stage.
7. The written test shall carry a total of 100 marks, comprising:
 - 60 Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs), each carrying 1 mark (Total: 60 marks); and
 - 1 Long Answer Question carrying 40 marks.There shall be negative marking of 0.25 marks for each incorrect answer in the MCQs.
8. Duration of 1 hour shall be allotted for the 60 MCQs, and 30 minutes shall be allotted for the Long Answer Question.
9. **No break shall be allowed between the MCQ section and the Long Answer Question.**
10. **No one will be allowed to leave the examination hall till completion of examination.**
11. The Long Answer Question scripts shall be evaluated only for those candidates who secure the minimum qualifying marks in the MCQ section, as follows:
 - General Category: 25% (15 out of 60)
 - SC / ST / PWD: 11 marks
 - OBC-A / OBC-B: 13.5 marks
12. The result of the Entrance Test shall be published on the official website, indicating the marks obtained in both the MCQ section and the Long Answer Question.
13. General rules and practices of Calcutta University examinations are applicable in this examination also where it is not mentioned specifically.
14. Mere appearance in the Entrance Test shall not confer any right to admission. The candidature of a candidate shall be liable to cancellation at any stage, including after the Entrance Test or even after admission, if found ineligible in accordance with the prescribed eligibility criteria.
