- APPLICANTS, ADMITTED IN EARLIER PHASE IN THE LOWER PREFERENCE ARE ELIGIBLE FOR COUNSELLING.
- APPLICANTS, SELECTED IN EARLIER PHASE BUT FAILED TO GET ADMITTED FOR A REASON WHATSOEVER ARE ELIGIBLE FOR COUNSELLING.
- CANDIDATES MUST REPORT AT THE VENUE AN HOUR BEFORE THE COUNSELLING TIME.
- CANDIDATES MUST BRING THE REQUIRED DOCUMENTS AND PAPERS AS MENTIONED HEREUNDER.
- CANDIDATES WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO LEAVE THE VENUE FOR ANY PURPOSE (i.e. XEROX etc) ONCE INSIDE THE VENUE.

4. Format of Affidavits (Annexure I & II) downloaded from admission portal and duly filled in and signed by deponents.
5. Self attested photocopies of all semesters/year's Mark sheets.
6. Self attested photocopies of proof of SC/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B/PWD/EWS candidate (if applicable)
7. Domicile Certificate of West Bengal for reserved category from outside the state of West Bengal.
8. One set of self attested photocopies of all relevant documents.

- The choices / preferences submitted by the candidates at the time of application will be processed and seat will be provisionally allotted in the order of merit.
