FAQ

Q#1. What is the general eligibility of the 2 Yr. PG course?

Ans. Following Graduates are eligible.

- a) 3 Yr. B.Sc. (H)/B.A. (H) at least 55% of marks in Hons. Subject.
- b) 4 Yr. B.Sc. /B.A. appeared or passed the 5th semester.
- c) 3 Yr. B.Sc. /B.A. with Single Major Subject.

Please Refer Section 3, 4, 5, 5A, 5B, 6 given in INFORMATION section under “2 Yr. M.Sc. / M.A. under Science Faculty – 2026” link.

Q#2. What is the stipulated year of passing of qualifying examination?

Ans. Current year plus four (04) preceding years (i.e. upto 2022 for the admission session 2026).

Q#3. Whether any hard copy of Application to be issued?

Ans. No, Apply through online only.

Q#4. Whether Application fee to be paid before online submission of application?

Ans. No, Application Fee to be paid after final submission through online mode.

Q#5. Can I save my online application part by part?

Ans. Yes, you can save part by part. You can get back the previous part (if saved).

Q#6. What are the soft copies of documents and their size required during submission of online application?

Q#7. Who is under PART-A?

Ans. Current year pass out student of C.U. under NEP 2020.

Q#8. Who is under PART-B?

Ans. All C.U. & NON-CU students current year plus four (04) preceding years (i.e. upto 2022 for the admission 2026) pass out.

Q#9. I am a current year pass out C.U student. My candidature will be under PART-A or PART-B?

Ans. In both PART-A and PART-B.

Q#10. How will I know the status of my application?

Ans. You have to follow website notice and student admission portal by using login ID (application no.) and password.

Q#11. Whether separate application to be submitted for P.G. Course in UG Colleges?

Ans. Yes. Contact respective college authorities for information.

Q#12. What are the documents that I have to upload?

Ans. Copy of

- (i) Academic credentials: All mark sheets from 10th, 12th, Graduation etc.,
- (ii) Age proof: Admit card/certificate of 10th standard as proof of DOB,
- (iii) Reservation proof: Valid SC/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B/PWD/EWS certificate (if applicable),
- (iv) Domicile certificate (applicable for the reservation category certificate issued other than Govt. of West Bengal),
- (v) Other document: Aadhaar Card, APPAR ID / ABC ID etc.

Q#13. Who can attest documents?

Ans. Self-Attested copy to be submitted. Candidate must sign all page of printed copy of Application form and documents.

Q#14. When printed copy of Application and documents to be submitted?

Ans. Candidates will have to submit printed copy of Application, copy of e-receipt and other testimonials after admission as notified in Admission Schedule.

Q#15. I am an appeared candidate in the final semester exam and result not yet published. How could I put honours marks obtained and full marks?

Ans. Appeared candidates put the marks obtained and full marks except last semester exam.

Q#16. I am a Non CU Candidate. How could I put the honours marks obtained and full marks?

Ans. Convert the CGPA * 10 = % of marks obtained and full marks as 100 if CGPA is calculated in 10 scale. Use (1+1+1) format/table.

Q#17. How could I fill up the application form, if both of marks obtained and CGPA are in marks sheet?

Ans. In academic details section of application form, choose 'CGPA' as 'NO' then enter obtained marks and full marks in respective field/column.

Q#18. I am not able to see courses and preference to choose.

Ans. Check U.G/last degree papers detail. Before entering marks, calculate your percentage of marks in offline and check for your eligibility. Then click (1+1+1) system and enter obtained marks and full marks accordingly.

Q#19. I am BA (Hons.) in Geography/ BA (Hons.) in Psychology/ BA (Hons.) in Anthropology, I want to apply in MA in Geography/ MA in Psychology/ MA in Anthropology. In which admission portal, I have to submit my application?

Ans. You have to submit/apply through "2Yr. M.Sc./M.A. Admission under Science Faculty 2026" using the link <http://caluniv-ucsta.net/msc-btech/>.

Q#20. I want to apply in 'M.Sc. in Museology'/ 'M.Sc. in Archeology'/ 'MA/M.Sc. in Journalism & Mass Communication'/ 'M.Sc. in Economics'. Which admission portal to use to submit my application?

Ans. **Science Graduate** should apply through "2Yr. M.Sc./M.A. Admission under Science Faculty 2026" using the link <http://caluniv-ucsta.net/msc-btech/> and **Arts Graduate** should apply through "M.A/M.Sc. (Economics, Archeology, Museology etc.)" using the link <http://www.caluniv-ucsta.net/ma/>. Please refer "Important Information about Exception" given under **INFORMATION** section.

Q#21. What is the significance of order of preference?

Ans. Please follow the "Section-7" of Information Brochure, Procedure of Application and Significance of order of preference & Group No.

Q#22. Who have to appear in Entrance Test?

Ans. All the CU & NON-CU applicants must have to appear in Entrance Test.

Q#23. What type of Entrance Test will be held?

Ans. MCQ type question and answer in CBT (Computer Based Test) mode.

Q#24. I have graduated from C.U. in current year, do I have to appear in Entrance Test?

Ans. Yes.

Q#25. I have graduated from C.U. in previous year, do I have to appear in Entrance Test?

Ans. Yes.

Q#26. I am a C.U. current year student and have appeared in final semester examination. Do I have to appear Entrance Test?

Ans. Yes.

Q#27. How much is application fee?

Ans. For GEN/OBC-A/OBC-B/EWS candidate Rs. 1000/- for each group of application and Rs. 500/- for SC/ST/PWD candidate.

Q#28. Whether Application Fee to be paid online?

Ans. Yes.

Q#29. What does 'Group' mean?

Ans. Please follow "Section-7" Procedure of Application (Group No. & Order of Preference) of information brochure.

Q#30. When the Entrance Test will be held?

Ans. Follow the admission schedule.

Q#31. What would be the venue of Entrance Test?

Ans. Venue of Entrance Test would be in Kolkata City only. No centre to be allotted outside Kolkata City.

Q#32. Can I pay application fee through Cash?

Ans. No.

Q#33. I submitted online Application. How will I pay Application Fee?

Ans. You have to pay Application Fee and application fee after online submission of application through the admission portal.

Q#34. I have paid Application Fee but my payment status remains pending?
